About 20 DataCAD Users Gathered at Jeff Tagerman's office on Congress Street in Boston for an informative evening of schmoosing and Datacad information.

Jeff's offices were in the 95% completion stage and the LCD Projector offered the guests a full view of all of his demonstrations.

Discussions and Training centered around:

- 1. Datacad PLUS LT Could THIS ever be?
- 2. Overview of DC 9.07 enhancements including O2C and the various new command keys
- 3. Jeff went on to explain some of the KEY elements he uses in setting up Clients offices for maximum productivity.
 - 3a. Default Sheets Jeff explained that a Default Sheet should contain all the information needed for a Project "Just add Project"Pre-Set your Layers, Grids, Snaps, Pen tables....etc......So that when the Default Is brought up you are all set and ready to go.
 - 3b. Two hand Cadding Left hand on the Keyboard Right Hand on the mouse
 - 3c. Keyboard shortcuts for everything....Alt I Identify/Set All , Alt Z Change Text Content....etc...
 - 3d. Memorize the location of F1-Entity, F2-Group, F3-Area....etc... for faster Cadding in all of the Menus
 - 3e. Use the (Rick Morse) Productivity Pack Tool Bars Now bundled with Datacad

3f. Use 3D GTV's

- 3g. The Old "comma" key trick for undo's
- 3h. Tweak the Program Preferences to suit your needs
- 3i. Use Oran Woody's EZ Tools (.dcx) for speed
- 3j. Insert Excel/Word Documents as Schedules....as well as many more very helpful hints

The remainder of the evening was devoted to DC+ and Jeff having to jump through hoopssuccessfully demonstrating the various questions thrown at him from the audience - (Manny Snyderman would have been proud)
